When a family or caregiver has specific concerns about a child's development or behavior, then Care Connections can provide support and interventions to help everyone work together on behalf of the child for a positive change.

Services are provided by early childhood professionals who are knowledgeable about child care matters and specialize in infant, young children and family interventions.



WHAT WE OFFER

Individual Child Focused Consultation

- On-site meetings with child care providers and parents.
- Classroom observations.
- Assessments & behavior support planning.
- Home visits with families to get their input and observe the child at home.
- Referrals to appropriate outside services if needed.
- Follow-up support.

Programmatic Consultation

- Classroom observations
- Strategies to promote the healthy social and emotional development of all children.
- Problem-solving and capacity building to improve the overall program quality.
- Director support, staff communication and team building.

Workshop and Trainings

Care Connections provides customized training opportunities for child care providers and parents on a variety of topics related to infant, toddler and preschool development.
