PARENT LEADERSHIP

The Parent Leadership in State Government Training Project provides leadership training for Michigan parents who want to help impact local, state and federal program planning and policy development. The training covers improving leadership skills, making meetings more effective, how to successfully handle conflict, and many other topics. Parents will also develop an individual action plan to build on their new leadership skills and ideas.

The June 2011 training program is for parents who have children enrolled in Children's Special Health Care Services (CSHCS), community mental health services and/or special education services. This training is being funded by the Michigan Family-to-Family Health Information and Education Center through a grant from the Health Resources and Services Administration. The training is for parents interested in developing leadership skills and using those skills to benefit Michigan families. The training will address core skills that support parents to be in leadership roles and will help parents be more involved in program decision-making and policy development.



Who can apply for the training? Any parent in Michigan who has a child or youth enrolled in Children's Special Health Care Services (CSHCS), community mental health services and/or special education services.

How long is the training session? On day one the training will be held from 1pm – 8pm. On day two the training will be held from 9am – 4pm. Parents need to attend both days.

Where is the training located? Okemos, June 27th and 28th, 2011.

Is there childcare provided during the training? No, however we provide reimbursement for money you spend on childcare while at the training.

Who pays for the training? There is no cost to parents to attend. Parents also receive an honorarium for their time, mileage reimbursement, and hotel accommodations. Meals during the training are provided.
