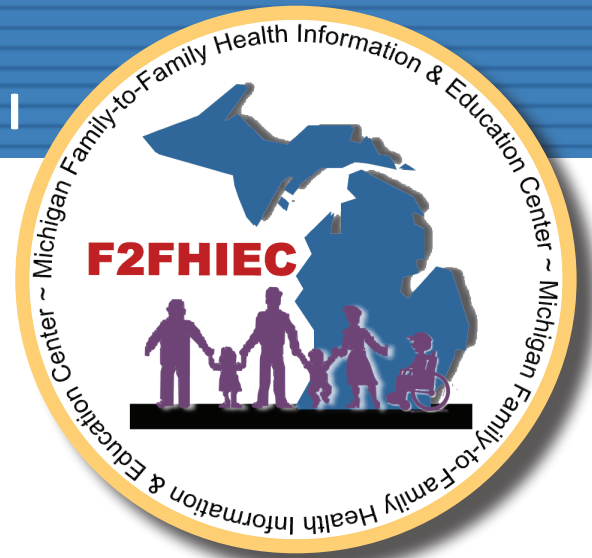


# Transition Planning? What's That? I Just Want to Help Young Adults Reach Their Hopes and Dreams: Part I
