

Adequate Yearly Progress measures year-to year student achievement on the MEAP test

2266 elementary & middle schools were included in the calculation of AYP

88% (1990 Schools) achieved AYP in 2001-02 34% (681 schools) for the 1^{st} time

28 schools were identified for school improvement for missing AYP targets for 2 consecutive years:

- Must notify parents
- Must offer option to transfer
- Must set aside Title I funds
- Must have 2 year improvement plan
- Eligible for technical assistance if improving

93 schools were identified to continue school improvement for missing AYP targets for 3 consecutive years:

- Must notify parents
- Must offer option to transfer
- Must offer supplemental services
- Must set aside Title I funds
- Eligible for technical assistance if improving
- Must continue to implement improvement plan

95 schools were identified for corrective action for missing AYP targets for 4 consecutive years:

- Share corrective action plan with parents & public
- Replace school staff relevant to missing AYP goal or
- Create new curriculum with professional development or
- Decrease management authority or
- Appoint an outside expert to advise or
- Extend the school year or school day or restructure the internal organization of the school.

There are no schools that have missed AYP targets for 5 or more consecutive years at this time.

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
